1.	Our previous comment is on the possibility of multiple pharmacists who verify the content. Is there an option for the “Fact Check” box to feature more than 1 person?	Revised
2.	For the purpose of this demo (MIL), there can just be 1 contributing organisation, which is PSS.	Revised
3.	There are already translations to other vernacular languages for some content, for example, selected MILs (Acarbose (healthhub.sg)). Currently, we host translated content in PDF files for users to download instead of housing them in HMTL pages considering the existing SP restrictions. However, we do not have a standard template how and where to display the links to the translated materials. While we try to move away from the PDF files, would WT recommend that we standardise how we display the links to content in other languages as part of the template and to be activated when needed?	UX needs to provide for a separate field in all content templates for HH to add hyperlinks for translations. They need flexibility to turn on/off this component as not all articles have translations.
4.	We do not need the partners logo footer on article pages. It is only needed on Homepage, need your help to remove from all content templates please.	<p>Footer links are usually global and standardized across website. But if we need to make this footer scalable to accommodate for omission of certain elements when on certain pages, it will have to be redesigned. 5.	Infographics options	Explained both infographics options to client and they are likely to go with the exhaustive template. No action needed on our end.

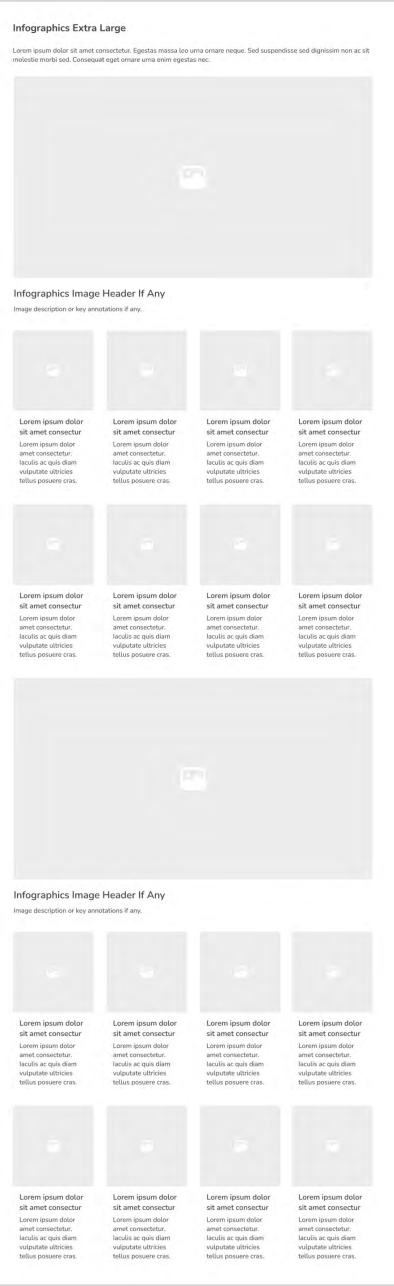
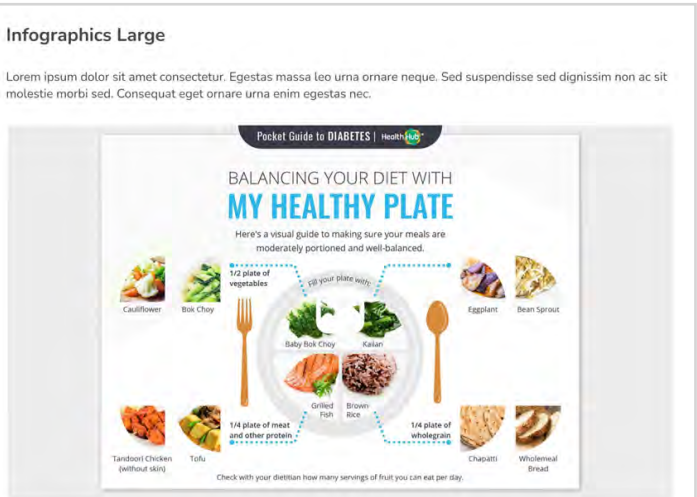
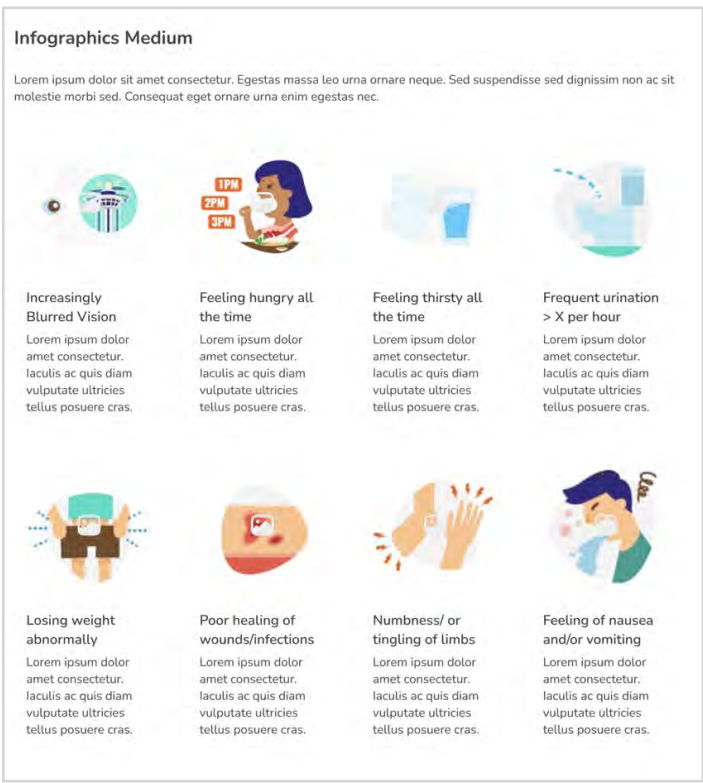
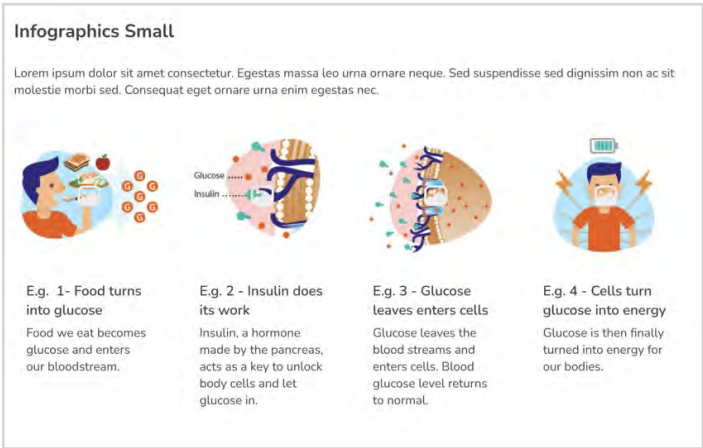
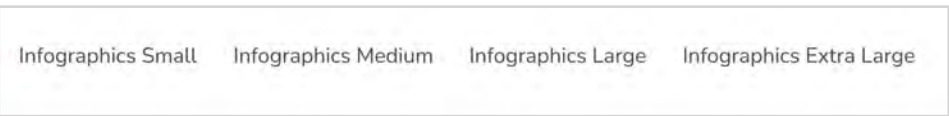


Infographics Templates (Exhaustive)
